Based at the Pine Glen Soccer Centre, a 100,000 square foot indoor soccer facility in North Oakville, the Club provides year-round recreational and competitive programming for both youth and adults.

ACTIVE START PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

OSC's Active Start Program provides the youngest players in soccer with the opportunity to develop their physical literacy skills such as running, jumping, kicking and changing direction. These skills are developed through fun, play-based activities lead by an Active Start Learning Facilitator along with the volunteer coach of the team. The aim of the Active Start program is to allow players to become comfortable with the sport of soccer in a setting that is built around fun and positive reinforcement.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS OF AN ACTIVE START MASTER LEARNING FACILITATOR INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Minimum two years as an Active Start Facilitator
- Supervise Active Start Facilitators
- Ensure proper uniform attire is worn at all times
- Must have completed the OSC Active Start course (date TBD)
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, and engaged at all times
- Facilitate the operation of the Active Start program (ensure all fields are properly set up, answer questions regarding the rules of play, distribute Club communications etc.)
- Provide quality customer service to players/parents and coaches
- Be on-time for all shifts
