Li'l Oscars/Active Oscars is a parented program that OSC has developed for participants ages 2-4. Using the principles of physical literacy, this program is designed to shape our future sports stars through active play-based activities that will develop coordination skills, listening skills and basic motor skills. Li'l Oscars/Active Oscars Facilitators will lead a fun and engaging 45-minute session each week that will help participants develop fundamental movement and social skills. This program runs Thursday evenings at 5:00pm & 6:00pm and Saturday mornings at 8:00am & 9:00am outdoor at the Pine Glen Soccer Centre.
