Alongside the tactical and technical attention, coaches will also be required to consider the psychological, social, and physical facets of the game, to deliver a well-rounded program for all players.

ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Deliver OSC's SDP Curriculum to U7-U16 players
- Provide a fun, inclusive and engaging environment and learning experience for players
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, and engaged at all times
- Minimum Ontario Soccer age/stage appropriate certification preferred
- Set up/take down fields to ensure the program is run successfully for all sessions
- Report directly to the Development Programs Manager & assist the Program Lead with tasks as required
- Compensation will be as discussed with Recreational Programs Manager and/or the Development Programs Manager
- Provide ongoing player feedback and end of season player evaluations
- Must have Ontario Soccer's Making Headway in Soccer and Rule of Two Certifications
- Successful applicants ages 18 and up will be required to submit a Vulnerable Sector Screening Check
