JOB DESCRIPTION

OSC's Oakville Wild Summer Soccer Camps run for nine weeks in the summer and are designed to provide campers of all soccer skill levels with a positive camp experience filled with soccer skill development through drills, activities and games, and the opportunity to meet new friends in a fun, play-based environment.

Reporting to the Director of Operations, the Camp Director is responsible for overseeing the day-to-day operations of the Oakville Wild Summer Soccer Camps. The Camp Director should be an experienced leader with coaching and supervisory experience. The Camp Director will be responsible for the supervision of all camp staff and volunteers , along with the general oversight of the safety and wellbeing of all campers.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

• Program Development:

- Design and develop the camp curriculum and activities.
- Ensure that the program has a diverse and engaging schedule of activities, ensuring a balance of skill development, teamwork, and fun
- Ensure coaches are delivering age and stage appropriate daily soccer drills and skill development activities to campers
- Staff Management:
 - Assist in recruitment, hiring, and training of camp coaches and volunteers.
 - Supervise and provide ongoing support to camp coaches and volunteers.
 - Ability to step in and coach if necessary
- Safety and Compliance:
 - o Develop and enforce safety protocols and emergency procedures
 - o Ensure all staff members are trained in relevant safety measures
 - Monitor allergies/health related concerns
- Parent Relations:
 - Maintain open and transparent communication with parents, providing regular updates on camp activities and address any concerns or questions
- Conflict Resolution:
 - Address and resolve any issues or conflicts that may arise with coaches, volunteers and campers.
 - Make decisions to ensure smooth camp operations.
- Evaluation and Improvement:
 - Conduct post-camp evaluations for all camp coaches on a weekly basis.
 - Use feedback to improve future camp programs.
- Administrative Tasks
 - Complete all administrative requirements for camp including, but not limited to managing waitlists, managing rosters, sign in/out sheets, camp groups, weekly coach/volunteer setup/clean-up schedules

- Soccer playing experience and coaching experience required
