OSC's Active Start/FUNdamentals Program provides the youngest players in soccer with the opportunity to develop their physical literacy skills such as running, jumping, kicking, and changing direction. These skills are developed through fun, play-based activities lead by an Active Start/FUNdamentals Facilitator along with the volunteer coach of the team. The aim of the Active Start/FUNdamentals program is to allow players to become comfortable with the sport of soccer in a setting that is built around fun and positive reinforcement.

- Deliver OSC's Active Start/FUNdamentals Curriculum to U5, U6, and U7 players
- Have attended OSC's Active Start workshop on May 3rd, 2025.
- Provide a fun, inclusive and engaging environment and learning experience for players
- Work with volunteer coaches and parents to provide a positive soccer experience to everyone involved
- Be enthusiastic, energetic, and engaged at all times
- Be on time for all sessions and assist with the set-up and tear down of the fields (all sessions will be held at Pine Glen Soccer Centre on the outdoor fields)
- Possess a valid Vulnerable Sector Screening Check (required for ages 18 and up)
