OSC FIELD AMBASSADOR & U8/U9 COACH MENTOR

OSC's Field Ambassador's role involves transporting and setting up field equipment required for U8/U9 house league programs. Upon completion of the fields being setup, they must monitor the equipment to ensure it is not being damaged and act as an OSC ambassador by answering any questions that parents or coaches may have. The Field Ambassador is responsible for the storage of all equipment required throughout the entire season. The Coach Mentor role is responsible for supporting and mentoring Volunteer House League Coaches in these age groups. Under the guidance of the Technical Department, all Coach Mentors will provide feedback, direction and assistance to ensure volunteer coaches are successful in their role.

ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have access to a vehicle and possess a valid driver's license to transport equipment to and from the fields. This could include but not limited to mini popup nets, larger bownets, corner flags and field signage.
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to game time to set up equipment required including soccer nets, pylons, corner flags, field signs, etc.
- Utilize evaluation techniques to provide constructive feedback to volunteer coaches, and complete coach evaluations to be provided to the Recreational Programs Manager.
- Assist coaches to provide a consistent approach to player development.
- Act as an OSC Ambassador by answering questions or providing information to parents, coaches, etc.
- Monitor and keep equipment throughout the soccer season.
- Must have Ontario Soccer's Making Headway in Soccer and Rule of Two Certifications
- Must have your Game Leader Certification
- FUNdamentals certification is an asset
- Applicants ages 18+ will be required to submit a Vulnerable Sector Screening Check if hired.
